Tuesday, November 9 *Virtual River Talk: Regional Water Quality in NJ's Great Waters.* 7-9 pm. Join the MWA for our next River Talk, a virtual Event to learn about threats to our region's water quality and the actions local communities can take to help protect our rivers.

Everyone enjoys recreating on water that appears clean, but it's a fact that many of our best recreational waters are impaired by pollutants, and several water-intensive projects have been proposed in the region. A panel of state, regional, and local water quality experts will provide their thoughts on New Jersey's recent 2018/2020 Integrated Water Quality Report, which focused on water quality for the Upper Delaware region, including the Musconetcong River. What does the report say about where we've been and where we are headed in terms of water quality? The talk will wrap up with actions that local governments and citizens can take to help maintain the recreational waters that we all enjoy.
